David Smith's TECHNICAL TID BITS

Well it has been a long HOT month even for NC. This months tech tip is not really a tech tip at all just a checklist for "**Road Trip Essentials for the Trunk.**" I think all of us at one time or the other started out on a road trip or just a longer than normal cruise and realized that we were in the need of perhaps one or two of these items.

- 1) **Extra coolant** can be bought premixed and will come in real handy if you overheat even just a little. (It is a whole lot cheaper at the auto parts store as opposed to a service station in BFE).
- 2) **A quart or two of oil.** Also in the same category a quart of transmission oil would not hurt. (it can also be used for power steering).
- 3) **A roll of duct tape.** I know HUH? I have used duct tape to patch a lot of things on the road (driving trucks for 40 years I have seen it all). Hoses, radiators power steering lines and even an exhaust that broke 4 inches in front of the muffler, held it up for over 100 miles.
- 4) **A bottle or scissors jack.** Which one of us really trusts that factory jack that is sitting in your trunk. I did not trust them when they were new.
- 5) **A small assortment of tools,** a couple of screwdrivers a small wrench and socket sets a razor knife vise grips pliers and electrical tape.
- 6) And last but not least a **cell phone** to call for help when you really need it.

Everything listed I have fit into a small plastic milk crate that fits in a small area of your trunk. Lining it with an old towel will insure to keep your trunk dry in case of a leak. These are just suggestions you can make a road trip goody box of whatever you want.

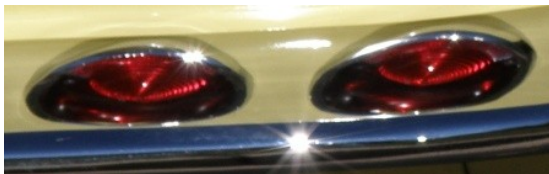

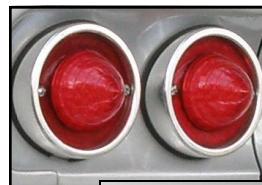

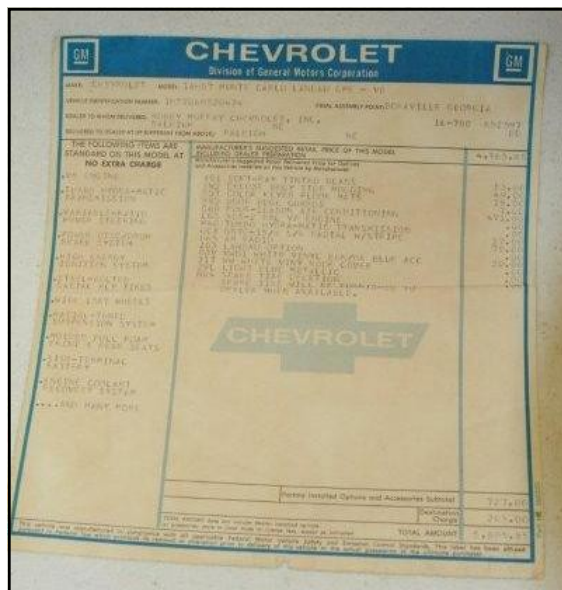
